NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ARIZONA STATE BOARD FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board for Charter Schools (the "Board") and to the general public that the Board will hold a meeting, open to the public, on **Monday, November 20, 2023 at 10:00 a.m**.

The **Monday, November 20, 2023** Board meeting will be a hybrid-access meeting. This means that the public has the opportunity to participate in-person or virtually. Information on how the public may attend is outlined below.

Please note the location of the **Monday, November 20, 2023** Board meeting: 1700 W. Washington St., Executive Tower, 3rd Floor Boardroom, Phoenix, AZ 85007. The boardroom will be open to members of the public at 9:00 a.m.

A copy of the meeting agenda is attached. The Board reserves the right to change the order of items on the agenda. One or more members of the Board may participate telephonically or virtually.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(H), the Board may discuss and take action concerning any matter listed on the agenda.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2), the Board may vote to convene in executive session, which will not be open to the public, for discussion or consideration of records exempt by law from public inspection.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), the Board may vote to convene in executive session, which will not be open to the public, for legal consultation and advice concerning any item on the agenda.

The deadline to submit a written comment is Thursday, November 16, 2023 at 12:00 PM.

Written comments received after the deadline, including those that are mailed but not received by staff, will not be posted and will not be provided to members.

Written comments will not be read into the record; however, staff will post all written comments received by the deadline on the Board's agenda by **Friday**, **November 17**, **2023 at 5:00 PM**.

Virtual Verbal Public Comment:

Individuals must submit a <u>Request to Speak Form</u> to provide a virtual verbal public comment at the meeting during the Call to the Public agenda item.

The deadline to submit a Request to Speak Form to provide a virtual verbal comment is Thursday, November 16, 2023 at 12:00 PM.

Once you submit this form, Board staff will contact you with information on how to access the meeting virtually. During the Call to the Public, those who submitted a Request to Speak Form will be called on to speak virtually during the Call to the Public agenda item.

The name in which you submit the form **MUST** match the name on the account when signing into the meeting to speak. Prior to the meeting, you may need to download the Zoom application to your device and create an account to ensure name matching. Board staff will only call speakers once and then will move on to the next speaker. If you miss your turn, Board staff will attempt again at the end of the list. The order in which names are called will be in the order in which the registrations are received.

Individuals who submit the form after the noon deadline on **Thursday, November 16, 2023** will not be provided the opportunity to give virtual verbal public comment at the meeting.

All Board policies in regard to public comment at in-person meetings are transferable to virtual verbal public comment for meetings. Virtual verbal public comment may be limited to three minutes by the Board President, unless the time limit is adjusted by the Board President, at the start of the meeting.

In-Person Verbal Public Comment:

Individuals must submit a <u>Request to Speak Form</u> in advance to provide an in-person verbal comment at the meeting. No Requests to Speak Form will be accepted on the morning of the meeting.

The deadline to submit a Request to Speak Form to provide an in-person verbal comment is Thursday, November 16, 2023 at 12:00 PM.

If submitting a Request to Speak Form, Board staff will call on you to speak during the Call to the Public agenda item.

The Request to Speak Form informs Board staff that you will be present in-person at the meeting to provide your public comment. Staff will not switch your registration to virtual if you fail to attend the meeting in-person.

Board staff will only call speakers one time. If a speaker is not ready and available to comment at that time, staff will move on to the next speaker. If you miss your turn, Board staff will attempt again at the end of the list. The order in which names are called will be in the order in which the registrations are received.

Individuals who submit a Request to Speak Form after the **12:00 pm deadline on Thursday, November 16, 2023** will not be provided the opportunity to give an in-person public comment at the meeting.

In-person verbal public comment may be limited to three minutes by the Board President, unless the time limit is adjusted by the Board President, at the start of the meeting.
