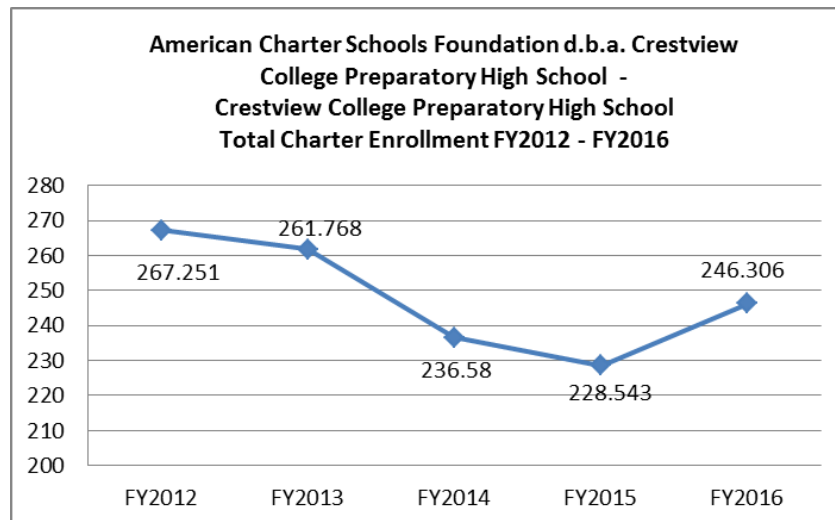

**II. Profile**

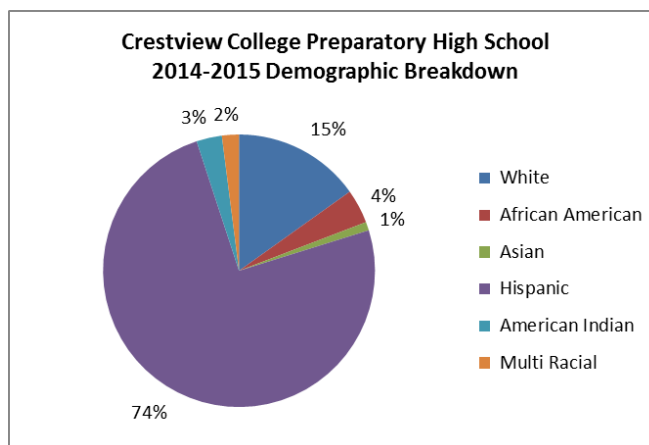
