Archway Classical Academy Cicero will follow accounting policies and procedures that comply with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP). Any procurement of goods and services shall be made by the procurement officer/authorized agent, in the best interest of the school, upon considering the totality of the circumstances surrounding the procurement, which may include but not be limited to, price, quality, availability, timelines, reputation and prior dealings.

Archway Classical Academy Cicero shall not purchase any goods or services from any member of the governing board, an immediate family member of any member of the governing board nor from any entity in which any member of the governing board or an immediate family member of a governing board member may benefit from such a procurement, unless authorized by the governing board after a full disclosure of the potential benefits, and after the consideration set forth in paragraph 1 above.

Archway Classical Academy Cicero understands that the policy cited above applies to purchases made using non-federal funds. As a condition of the receipt of certain federal funds, federal procurement requirements still apply.

IV. Review and Possible Approval of Documents Relating to Facility Financing

Mr. Huseth noted that the documents distributed prior to the meeting include the leases to be entered into between Archway Classical Academy-Central Scottsdale and Great Hearts as well as the lease and loan documents entered into by Great Hearts and guaranteed by Archway Classical Academy-Central Scottsdale. Dr. Scoggin said he has reviewed them and found them to be accurately prepared and representative of a financial transaction of clear benefit to Archway Classical Academy-Central Scottsdale.

Dr. Scoggin motioned, seconded and voted to approve the documents relating to facility financing as presented at 11:24 a.m.

V. Review and Possible Approval of Lease Agreement for Charter School Facilities at the Pavilions at Talking Stick

Mr. Huseth noted that the lease between Archway Classical Academy-Central Scottsdale and Great Hearts was prepared and distributed prior to the meeting. The lease delineates the terms of the lease and the financial structure. Great Hearts is the landlord and Archway Classical Academy-Central Scottsdale is the lessee. The term of the lease is consistent with the under-arching ground lease between the landlord and Great Hearts: Until August 2042 for the initial term with the option to renew, which Great Hearts plans to extend once the ground lease is renewed. The amount of rent payment is based on 15% of the school's per pupil state revenue or a proportionate share of the debt service for the ground lease and bond financing, whichever is higher. Dr. Scoggin noted the 15% is in line with national best practices determining what charters should pay for facilities. Given the strong lease term and strong

financial structure, he will approve the lease agreement.
