Dear Kim,

During the Board Meeting I had suggested our willingness to surrender both of the Charters at the end of the school year to ease the burden on both our parts with regards to the time and expense of all the hearings.

The Board referenced that they were not the ones to decide that, but it is my understanding that that offer should be forwarded to you. I am not in a financial position to have a lawyer draw up the proposal, so I hope it is appropriate to forward this to you directly.

With the hearing dates so close to the end of the year, and in consideration of the time allowed for notification and due process, the year would be ended. I would be willing to surrender the charters at the end of the fiscal year in exchange for completion of our financial contract with the State so that we could continue to cover our obligations to our students, staff, and vendors.

This transition would be the best for our students, for testing stability, as well as a smooth transition for all our graduates. It would also go a long way to maintain the stability of charter schools as a stable option for families.
