Non-Compliance with Fingerprinting Requirements The Board will receive information to determine whether evidence exists that Vechij Himdag Alternative School, Inc. is in breach of one or more provisions of its charter contract, federal, state, or local laws regarding its failure to comply with the fingerprinting requirements prescribed in A.R.S. §15-183.C or A.R.S. §15-512. If the Board determines that a breach may have occurred, the Board may take action as it deems appropriate or necessary under state law, which may include imposing a civil penalty of one thousand dollars per occurrence.
- <u>Non-submission of Fiscal Year 2008 Audit</u> The Board will receive information to determine whether evidence exists that the following schools are in breach of one or more provisions of their charter contract, federal, state, or local laws.

If the Board determines that a breach may have occurred, the Board may take action as it deems appropriate or necessary under state law, which may include but is not limited to issuance of a Notice of Intent to Revoke the Charter pursuant to A.R.S. §15-183.I and/or adding to the basis of the current 10% withholding pursuant to A.R.S. §15-185.H.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3), the Board may vote to go into Executive Session which will not be open to the public, for the purposes of receiving legal advice.
