


Copper Point Schools Track 1 Instructional Days Narrative:

School Day Compliance with ARS § 15-341-01

Copper Point Junior High School will have 178 days. This is in compliance of paragraph B, "For the purposes of this section, "one hundred eighty days" means one hundred eighty days of instruction or an equivalent number of minutes of instruction per school year based on a different number of days of instruction approved by the school district governing board or charter school governing body". Our students complete a modified four day schedule one week out of each month, with the remainder of each week in a five day schedule. This allows for the junior high school team to collaborate with the high school team on unified days for professional development.

Hours Compliance with ARS § 15-901

Our students will have the 1231 hours, well over the minimum of 890 hours required for 6th grade and 1068 hours required for 7th and 8th grades.

School Day

Copper Point Schools will hold classes from 8:30-3:50. There will be no early release days.

Minutes per Course:

Each Class period will meet for 65 minutes per course for standard classes. Passing periods are 5 minutes long. Lunch is a 30 minute session, with a support class also being 30 minutes. Each day, students will go to Crew, which is 30 minutes long.

Copper Point Schools Track 2 Instructional Days Narrative:

School Day Compliance with ARS § 15-341-01

Copper Point High School will have 160 days. This is in compliance of paragraph B, "For the purposes of this section, "one hundred eighty days" means one hundred eighty days of instruction or an equivalent number of minutes of instruction per school year based on a different number of days of instruction approved by the school district governing board or charter school governing body". Our students complete a modified 4 day schedule, with the beginning of each semester at 5 day as an orientation period. The 4 day week allows for collaboration, community service, clubs, sports and tutoring to take place on selected Friday throughout the year.

Hours Compliance with ARS § 15-901

Our students will have the 1106, well over the minimum of 720 required by the statute.

School Day

Copper Point Schools will hold classes from 8:30-3:50. There will be no early release days.

Minutes per Course:

Each Class period will meet for 65 minutes per course. This time frame gives students well over the 61.5 hours required (89.83 Semester 1, 96.83 Semester 2). Passing periods are 5 minutes long. Lunch is a 30 minute session, with a support class also being 30 minutes. Each day, students will go to Crew, which is 30 minutes long.
