


Alternative School Stories and Success

I am a 15 year old student that has always had a rough time at school. Ever since I was seven, I have jumped from school to school constantly because of the bullies and the education was not a good fit for me. I have gone to almost every middle school in Yavapai County area.... And then I came here.

Today, I am at such an amazing school that provides me with all the help and education I need. At this school, we don't worry about fitting in because we are all unique in our own ways. The kids don't have to worry about being judged for their troubled past because coming here helps them with a new and fresh start. I am also a student who has been in trouble. BIG TROUBLE. At my last school, they told me it would be best to go to this alternative school to get caught up and turn my behavior around. I took them up on that offer, and in the little time I've been here, I have received two student awards and I've nearly caught up on all my credits. I am going to graduate on time.

This alternative school has been helping me get caught up with credits I lost while I was transferring schools. They have provided all the students (including me!) with an online education to even work on at home. The way this alternative school is set up has helped me catch up really quickly with classes I am behind in. Also, the staff here are excellent because there is AZ more one-on-one attention from them.

This last time I had gotten into trouble I had to go into a rehab type program, this program just so happened to make us go to Transition school. After my 2 months in the program had ended, I decided to attend school at their other campus called Yavapai County High School.
