Policy Statement Charter Board Officer Election

The purpose of the policy is to provide guidelines for electing the Board President and Vice President.

Policy

The State Board for Charter Schools ("Board") shall elect a President and a Vice President at its first regular Board meeting each year.

Board members shall nominate themselves or others to serve in the position of President and Vice President during the agenda item to elect officers. Those nominated must affirm that they are seeking the position.

A vote shall be taken on each position or taken as a slate. A nominee will require at least six votes to win the position. Multiple votes may be taken until a nominee acquires at least six votes. If no nominee acquires at least 6 votes, the Board shall consider the election of officers at the subsequent regular Board meeting. The President shall continue to serve in the position until a new President is elected.

If a vacancy occurs in the office of President, the Vice President shall immediately become the President. As soon as practicable, the Board shall elect a new Vice President.
