
I. Performance Summary

II. Profile

During the financial performance response review process, Board staff and the Charter Holder determined there was a material misstatement in the fiscal year 2015 financial statements. In April 2016, the auditor reissued the financial statements. Based on the reissued fiscal year 2015 financial statements, the Charter Holder meets the Board's Financial Performance Expectations. Had the reissued financial statements been received by the Board prior to the notification of renewal eligibility, the Charter Holder would have been waived from submitting a financial performance response. Therefore, the financial performance response submitted by the Charter Holder with its renewal application has not been included in the meeting materials.


