**MOTION TO MODIFY THE**  
**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW**  
**JUDGE’S DECISION**

23 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.08(B), undersigned counsel requests that the  
24 Arizona State Board for Charter Schools (“Board”) modify and accept the Findings of  
25 Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order contained in the Administrative Law Judge  
26 Decision dated July 23, 2014 as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Adopt Findings of Fact Nos. 1 through 14 in their entirety.

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**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Adopt Conclusions of Law Nos. 1 through 3 in their entirety.

2. Modify Conclusion of Law No. 4 to correct the citation and contents of A.R.S. § 15-183(I)(4) as follows<sup>1</sup>:

A sponsor may revoke a charter at any time if the charter school breaches one or more provisions of its charter. A.R.S. § 15-183(I)(4) provides that a sponsor shall give a charter operator at least *60* days written notice before the effective date of the proposed revocation of a charter. The notice is required to contain a statement of reasons for the proposed revocation. The charter operator is then given *at least 60* days to correct the problems associated with the reasons for the proposed revocation.

This modification is requested for the reason that the requirement for the Board to give written notice to a charter operator is contained in A.R.S. § 15-183(I)(4). Moreover, the notice and correction period required under A.R.S. §15-183(I)(4) is at least sixty days.

3. Adopt Conclusions of Law Nos. 5 through 14 in their entirety.

**ORDER**

Adopt the recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge in its entirety and order that the charter between the Board and Arizona School for Integrated Academics and Technologies, Inc. be revoked.
