1. Describe the reason for the change in instructional days, including how it will improve pupil achievement in the target population.

The local school district recently voted to move all district schools to a 4-day week. They did this to reduce operations costs and to aid with teacher retention, both of which have been negatively impacted by severe and ongoing budget cuts.

We also need to move to a 4-day week to reduce operations costs and aid with teacher retention. In addition to financial considerations, we need to keep a consistent schedule with surrounding schools to aid families with planning and transportation; many families have children at different schools. This change will also reduce transportation costs for families; the school does not have buses, so families outside our immediate community provide their own transportation from Apache Junction, Florence, Superior, and Globe.

This change will improve student achievement by supporting the recruitment and retention of quality teachers who may see a 4-day week as a benefit that offsets salary stagnation and decreases due to budget cuts. Students also see a 4-day week as a benefit, which increases motivation.

2. Describe how the school calendar and daily instructional schedule(s) provided demonstrate compliance with A.R.S. §15-901 regarding annual instructional hours for each grade served.

For the 2015-16 school year, SDS will serve grades 5-12. A.R.S. §15-901 requires 890 annual instructional hours for grades 5-6, 1,000 instructional hours for grades 7-8, and 720 instructional hours for grades 9-12.

Students will receive the required number of instructional hours by lengthening the school day. Students are scheduled to receive 7 hours of instruction per day for 144 days. This will result in 1,008 instructional hours.

3. Describe whether the change will apply to all schools operated under the charter, or to identified school sites only.

Sonoran Desert School is the only school operated under the charter. The change will apply to Sonoran Desert School only.

4. Provide the timeline for implementing the change, including whether the Instructional Days Amendment Request will be submitted in conjunction with any other amendment or notification requests which would warrant concurrent consideration.

The change will be implemented in the 2015-16 school year and continue thereafter. The start date for the implementation will be August 10, 2015 (fiscal year starting July 1, 2015).

No other amendment or notification requests which would warrant concurrent consideration have been submitted.
