

Arizona State Board for Charter Schools Website Link to Performance Dashboards: Frequently Asked Questions

Each charter school must conspicuously and permanently post a link on its website to the charter school's academic performance dashboard and the charter holder's financial and operational performance dashboards on the Board's website. [A.A.C. R7-5-501(E)]

Where must the link be posted on the charter school's website?

The charter school must post the link in a noticeable place on its website. While the rule does not preclude the link from also being posted on other websites, such as the charter holder's website or a "district" or "network" website, to comply with the Board's rule, the link must be available through each school's website.

By when must the charter school post the link on its website?

Each Board-sponsored charter school that operated in fiscal year 2019 must conspicuously post the link on its website by August 1, 2019. For new schools, the link must be posted by September 1 of the charter school's first year of operation. The link must remain on the school's website until the school ceases to operate.

Does the school have to post separate links for the academic, financial and operational performance dashboards?

No. The link to the charter holder's "Performance" tab in ASBCS Online must only be posted once on the charter school's website. From this one link, all three performance dashboards may be accessed. A file has been posted on the <u>Board's website</u> for fiscal year 2020 that contains the "Performance" tab link for each charter holder.

Why did the Board require a link to be posted instead of screenshots of the performance dashboards themselves?

Each year's academic, financial and operational performance dashboards become available or are updated at various times throughout the year. By having charter schools post a link to the charter holder's "Performance" tab in ASBCS Online, the most current performance information will always be accessible without requiring charter schools to regularly make updates to their websites.
