AGENDA ITEM EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Charter Holder Change in Governance and Authorized Representative

Request

Arizona Academy of Science & Technology ("Charter Holder") submitted amendment requests to change its authorized representative, add one new corporate board member and remove three of its five corporate board members.





