

Items for Discussion:

1. Add 12th Grade

(The Board may decide to move into executive session pursuant to ARS §38-431.03(A)(3) and ARS §38-431.03(A)(4) for advice of counsel.)

Debra Slagle explained to the board that currently less than 20 students are matriculating to 12th grade at Canyon View Prep; Jack Rowe is working on the required curriculum samples to present to the Arizona State Board for Charter Schools. Debra called for a motion to add the 12th grade for the 2013-2014 school year. Motion to add the 12th grade was initiated by board member Dawn Revere; board member Peggy Armstrong second the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Renewal of Charter

(The Board may decide to move into executive session pursuant to ARS §38-431.03(A)(3) and ARS §38-431.03(A)(4) for advice of counsel.)

Debra Slagle announced to the board that the Arizona State Board for Charter Schools renewed the charter for another 20 years. As part of the report regarding the Charter renewal, she reviewed the embargoed results of the reading/writing score for the high school.

3. Canyon View – Separate Site

(The Board may decide to move into executive session pursuant to ARS §38-431.03(A)(3) and ARS §38-431.03(A)(4) for advice of counsel.)

Kris Ward motioned to submit an application to the SBCS to designate Canyon View Prep as a separate site or Park View Middle School, thus having CVP grades 9-12 and PVMS grades 6-8; Peggy Armstrong second the motion; motion passed unanimously.



Add Charter Grades Amendment Narrative

Park View School, Inc. has been serving students since 1999. Until two years ago, students were served in grades 6-8. After moving to a new facility, grades 9-11 were added. There are less than twenty students who will be matriculating to twelfth grade next year, and want to finish their high school experience as a part of this learning community.

The addition of grade twelve supports our mission of equipping students for college and beyond. Our educational philosophy is to provide a rigorous curriculum in the context of care and concern, differentiating instructional delivery to meet the needs of a variety of learners.

Teachers have been trained in the Danielson Method, and their instruction is evaluated relative to the implementation of this method. Instructional delivery includes a student centered classroom; effective questioning strategies to determine how students are progressing relative to mastery of the content; the use of benchmarking and formative assessments in multiple formats to assess student learning. The curriculum is aligned with the Common Core Curriculum, and students must demonstrate mastery on summative assessments at a 65% level in order to receive credit. Students must get a 65% or higher in a class in order to get credit for the course. Students must meet the following requirements in order to obtain their high school diploma: four credits of English, four credits of Math, three credits of Science, three credits of Social Studies (World History, American History, Government/ Economics), two credits of foreign language, one credit of performing art, and five credits in elective courses. Park View has an IGA with Yavapai College and the Yavapai County JTED through which Park View students take classes.

An assistant principal with a strong background as a highly effective teacher has been hired to ensure that there is a strong instructional leadership team to support the addition of grade levels. Park View already has highly qualified teachers in most of the content areas that will be offered to the twelfth graders. An additional English teacher who is highly qualified has been hired to cover the additional section of English that will be offered. All teachers who are hired must meet the federal guidelines for Highly Qualified.

Dear Board Members:

I am respectfully submitting the following three amendments on behalf of Park View School, Inc. : amendment to add a grade level; Notification to add a site to Park View School, Inc. and amendment to change site specific grade levels for Park View Middle School.

Two years ago, we added grades nine and ten; and last year we added eleventh grade to accommodate the students who would be matriculating into that grade and who were already enrolled at Park View. We want to add twelfth grade next to accommodate those students who will be matriculating from eleventh grade for the 2013-2014 school year.

It has been our intent upon moving to our new facility to separate the high school and the middle school. With the addition of the twelfth grade, it has become more significant to officially have separate middle and high schools. For example, if the Board approves the addition of the twelfth grade, we are sure the seniors next year would prefer not to have Park View Middle School on their diplomas. The high school has been operating with a *dba* of Canyon View Prep as voted on by the community. By having the high school as an official site, it would also assist parents in being able to more easily find information regarding the school.

Finally, if the Board approves the notification of the separate site, the grades served at Park View Middle School will need to be amended to reflect grades six through eight.
