## Narrative Explaining Great Hearts Academies—Anthem Preparatory Academy Grades Served Change from 3-12 to K-12

Not only is there tremendous demand for classical K-5 curriculum across the Phoenix metropolitan region (and demonstrated by the successes of other classical schools within and without Great Hearts), but there is a tremendous interest within Great Hearts' existing family base. As of Dec 1, 2012, Great Hearts has already received 4153 K-5 applications for 2013-14. ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY believes that adding grades K through 2 to its existing grades 3 through 5 would elevate the quality of its overall program and support its mission. Great Hearts believes that a rigorous K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade classical education is a key curricular component to improving the educational quality of ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY and the quality of schools generally in the vicinity.

In all courses, the K-5 Grade curriculum is constructed to achieve two goals: (1) to bring students with disparate educational backgrounds up to a mastery level before 6<sup>th</sup> Grade, and (2) to support the particular subjects taught in 6<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> Grade with a K-5 foundation in skill and content. To maximize the successful achievement of these goals, ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY and Great Hearts believe that instruction in this curriculum must begin in Grade K.

The K-2 curriculum at ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY will be a tested, classical Core Knowledge curriculum that has been tied to and mapped onto Arizona State Standards. This K-2 program and curriculum has already seen great success at Archway Chandler, Archway Scottsdale, Archway Trivium, Archway Veritas, and Teleos Preparatory Academy as part of their K-5 curriculum, as demonstrated by the 2012 Stanford 10 NRT scores and parent satisfaction survey results described below. The test rankings below are given as Normal Curve Equivalents (NCE), where 50 is considered average.

#### Expected Academic Achievement for AIMS, AIMS DPA, and Coursework Mastery

ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY expects the minimum levels of academic achievement for its new K through 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders:

- > 100% Mastery of coursework for students matriculating from K to 1<sup>st</sup> and from 1<sup>st</sup> to 2nd Grade.
- ➤ For 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders, students will exceed the state average scale score on the Stanford 10 by at least 10%.
- Pass rates on 3 5<sup>th</sup> Grade AIMS test that out-pace local district schools by at least 10%
- Raw AIMS scores in the top 40% of all 3-5 students compared to schools statewide.
- ➤ 100% Mastery of coursework for students who matriculate from 5<sup>th</sup> into 6<sup>th</sup> Grade.

#### **Timeline for Implementation**

If this amendment is approved, ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY will add two sections each of K through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade in the fall of 2013-14.

#### **Changes in Staffing**

At ANTHEM PREPARATORY ACADEMY, adding 2 sections each of grades K through 2 will require the hiring of 8 additional full time teachers and 6 full time aides. All teachers will be Highly Qualified inasmuch as it is required by state and/or federal statute.
