Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(H), the Board may discuss and take action concerning any matter listed on the agenda.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2), the Board may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, for the discussion or consideration of records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state law.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) the Board may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, for legal advice concerning any item on the agenda.

The Board will receive information to determine whether evidence exists that New Destiny Leadership Charter School is in breach of one or more provisions of its charter contract, federal, state, or local laws, including but not limited to, failing to provide a program of instruction during FY 2013, failing to submit the fiscal year 2012 annual financial statement and compliance audit, and failing to submit the annual financial report. If the Board determines that a breach may have occurred the Board may issue a Notice of Intent to Revoke the Charter pursuant to A.R.S. 15-183(I).
  - 2. The Board will receive information to determine whether evidence exists that the DCS Partners, Inc. continues to breach one or more provisions of its charter contract, federal, state, or local laws regarding failure to timely submit the annual financial audit in accordance with A.R.S. § 15-183(E)(6). The Board will also consider whether evidence exists that the Charter Holder is in breach of one or more provisions of its charter contract or state law when it failed to demonstrate compliance with federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act requirements, and failed to submit to the Board the required

documentation to change its charter representative. If the Board determines that a breach may have occurred the Board may take action as it deems appropriate or necessary under state law, which may include but is not limited to adding to the basis of the withholding and issuance of a Notice of Intent to Revoke the Charter pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-183(I).

3. The Board will receive information to determine whether evidence exists that the following charter holders continue to breach one or more provisions of its charter contract, federal, state, or local laws regarding failure to timely submit the annual financial audit in accordance with A.R.S. § 15-183(E)(6). If the Board determines that a breach may have occurred the Board may take action as it deems appropriate or necessary under state law, which may include but is not limited to issuance of a Notice of Intent to Revoke the Charter pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-183(I).
